

Crosthwaite and Lyth Neighbourhood Plan – can you help?

Crosthwaite and Lyth Parish Council is creating a Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish

An application for grant support has been approved and Kirkwells Planning Consultants have been engaged to support the process. Fundamental to progress is the Neighbourhood Plan Working Group (NPWG) which manages day-to day progress and makes recommendations to the Parish Council on how the plan should be constructed. Meetings of the NPWG are formal and public and Terms of Reference have been agreed and are on the Parish Council Website.

All Members of the Parish Council have been appointed to the Working Group, but it is now looking to bring on other members of the community (up to a maximum of five people) who have an interest in working with the Group.

Expressions of Interest will be considered by the NPWG which will make recommendations to the next meeting of the Parish Council which will confirm appointments to the Group, reserving the right to decline applications if, in its judgement, an applicant has not demonstrated relevant attributes.
