NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN WORKING GROUP 16 JANUARY 2023

Report on Agenda Item 10 - Background

In preparing this Agenda, I had deliberately limited the scope of background to 2022, and that remains the case in the following detail, written for the purposes of tonight's meeting.

It is of course self-evident however that considerable work was done to develop a plan prior to 2022 and Louise Kirkup has confirmed:

- a) That elements of this work will be incorporated in the draft plan
- b) That all work undertaken will need to be listed in the Consultation Statement

Bearing that in mind therefore, this report remains a summary of developments over the last 6 months, simply to give context to the current situation. That summary is as follows:

From the Minutes of the Parish Council:

- May 2022 (Ordinary PC meeting): "The new Terms of Reference had been circulated to Councillors and were Agreed"
- June 2022: It was reported that: "A meeting with an independent consultant and a development session with ACT had been arranged by the Chair and Vice-Chair for attendance by the Councillors".
- September 2022: The Chairman reported that discussions had been ongoing over the summer including telephone, email and face to face conversations within the Parish Council and with external consultants. This had included a meeting with Lorrainne Smyth, Chief Executive of ACT, who had recommended that the Parish Council must take a balanced view on whether a Neighbourhood Plan or a Community Led Plan would best suit the needs of the village. As part of this information gathering exercise, the Parish Council is now seeking a meeting with LDNPA planners. It was Agreed that a full report and recommendation would be made to the meeting on October 3rd.
- October 2022: The Clerk presented a Report to the PC which confirmed that the PC would continue with a Neighbourhood Plan and included a 10-point Action Plan. It was agreed that reports to the PC would be made public by posting on the PC website
- November 2022: Progress with the Action Plan was reported.
- December 2022: Progress with the Action Plan was reported as follows:
 - 1. Amendments to the Terms of Reference were agreed
 - 2. Maintain liaison with Kirkwells:
 - Louise Kirkup happy to re-engage with the Plan
 - LK Agreed to provide updated Consultants Fee Proposals for a bid for grant
 - LK agreed to attend a scoping meeting in early January
 - 3. Complete and submit a new application for grant funding: DONE: completed during December
 - 4. Appointments to the Neighbourhood Plan Working Group: 6 Parish Councillors plus the Chairman as an ex officio Member were confirmed as members of the Group. A call for volunteers was posted on the website and in the Parish Magazine
 - 5. Call for volunteers as already reported
 - Meetings with External Advisors: A report was presented to Councillors on their meeting with Dave McGowan (recently retired Head of Development Management at LDNPA and n ow acting as a freelance planning consultant). He had provided balanced

and pragmatic advice on how the Council should proceed and offered to assist with any future technical drafting requirements.

- 7. Reports to be included as part of the Minutes: adopted
- 8. Reports to be included as part of the Agenda: Adopted
- 9. Agreement for the NPWG to meet to take matters forward: Agreed to meet on 16 January 2023
- 10. The Clerk to provide administrative support: underway.

On 12 January 2023 a meeting was held with Louise Kirkup who has offered to prepare a draft plan to be presented at the next meeting of the Working Group in the week commencing 30 January.
